Local Committee and Board Appointments

The Township of Hamilton is reaching out to engage its citizens – calling for people who are interested in becoming citizen members of local committees and board for the purpose of providing advice to Council on matters within the committee's mandate and to administer matters under specific Provincial legislation.

To be eligible to participate as a committee or board member, applicants must be a Township of Hamilton resident and/or a property owner and cannot be employed by the township or a local board. This will be a 4 year term.

In January, Council will be considering the appointments to the following committees and board:

Committee/Board Name	Purpose of committee/board
Accessibility Advisory Committee	To enhance the ability of persons with disabilities to have equal access to opportunities within the municipality
Heritage Advisory Committee	To provide guidance on conservation and promote the history and culture of the township.
Cold Springs Memorial Hall Advisory Committee	To advise and make recommendations on matters of programs, policies, events that meet the greater needs of the general public and user group interest.
Cold Springs Park Advisory Committee	
Old Camborne Schoolhouse & Playground Advisory Committee	
Nominations Committee	To provide input into various recognition and award programs and facilitate the submission of the applications.
Fence Viewers	To serve as arbitrators of disputes between owners of adjacent properties regarding boundary fences.
Property Standards Committee	To hear an appeal from a Property Standards Order and may confirm, modify or quash the order or extend time for compliance.
Parks & Recreation Advisory Committee	To advise and make recommendations on the programming and utilization of the facilities that meet the greater need of residents of the Township and Community user groups.
Police Services Board	To work with OPP in setting up policing priorities for the township.
