Maclean's Magazine has recently conducted research and posted an article on their [Macleans.ca website](http://Macleans.ca) stating that Hamilton Township is one of the safest places to live in Canada. Specifically, our Township has placed as the 5th safest places to live.

The report ranks communities according to Statistics Canada's Uniform Crime Reporting Survey, a measure of all police-reported crime. It also includes information on a number of factors including: population, number of homicides, homicide rate, break and entering rate and assault rate.
