

Municipal Drinking Water System Annual Inspections

Quality drinking water for the residents of the Township of Hamilton is important to Council and staff of the municipality and we have systems and procedures in place to achieve this.

In addition, the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change (MOECC) conducts annual inspections of systems across the Province. The 2015-16 Inspection for Creighton Heights Drinking Water System took place on November 30, 2015 and the Camborne Drinking Water System was inspected on February 11, 2016. The main purpose of these inspections is to confirm that the Drinking Water Systems are in compliance with MOECC legislation and in conformance with the drinking water guidelines and policies during the inspection period.

The Creighton Heights Drinking Water System received a final Inspection Rating of 98.2% and the Camborne Drinking Water System received 100%.
