**Dear Resident,**

**You may notice construction work on June Ave and Catherine St. In September/October, cement relining of the watermains will begin. This work is being conducted to increase the design life of the watermains in your Community.**

**Who:** The Contractor, New Tide Construction Ltd, will be performing the construction work for the Township of Hamilton.

**Why:** In order to increase longevity of the existing watermain infrastructure and preserve the recently improved road, cement relining is the chosen method for improving the water distribution system.

**What:** A temporary watermain will be set up and tested (blue pipe laying on ground and through culverts). Once results are received and are acceptable, your home will be switched to the temporary water system that will supply you with safe, potable drinking water for the duration of the relining project. The existing watermains will be cleaned out and lined with a cementitious layer that protects the watermain and improves water quality and pressure.

**When:** This work is planned to begin in late September, 2022. Completion is anticipated by early to mid November.

**Where: June Ave from Ontario St to Buttersfield Park  
Catherine St from June Ave to Olivers Lane**

**Construction Disruptions:** The Contractor will take every precaution to minimize disruptions to the everyday life of your family and/or the operation of your business. As you can appreciate, there may be some inconvenience during the course of the work such as minor traffic delays, parking restrictions and noise. We would like to thank you for your patience and co-operation. There may be times of disruption of water supply, where you may want to fill buckets and pots with water to carry your household through, until supply is restored. New Tide gives notices for such planned disruptions. Please check for notices in your doors and mailboxes.

**Impact on Public Property:** The reconstruction work is within the Township's right of way but may result in minor disruption to part of the private property directly adjacent to the work area. Lawns, pathways, garden and/or driveways may be disturbed. The affected areas will be reinstated as soon as possible after construction is completed. However, if you have plants or any other assets located within the Township's right of way that you want to preserve, we suggest that you may want to move the plants in preparation for the construction work.
