Council Decisions

At the Council Meeting on June 15, 2021, Township of Hamilton Council unanimously agreed to open the Boat Launch at Gore's Landing. Earlier this month, Council had planned to close the launch to motorized boats to reduce activity, parking conflicts and congestion at this location as part of the Province's Reopening of Ontario Framework. However, we heard overwhelming response from the Community to keep the facility open.

"Sometimes we get it wrong and this is one of those times", said Mayor Bill Cane, continuing, "We have really tried to increase our access and openness through improvements to the website, increased social media and new online outreach tools. Public input and comments are important to us and we have a Public Question period built right into our agenda. We have taken these steps to get as much input as we can before we make a decision."

We know each decision will not please everyone, but we value the participation and input from our residents. The feedback and suggestions provided in this particular instance will be forwarded to staff and to our Parks and Recreation Committee who are working on a new Parks Master Plan.

We want to keep our community safe and want people to be able to experience the range of opportunities available in our Township. We will continue to monitor and manage the use of our facilities as we progress through the Stages of the Reopening of Ontario.
