The Township of Hamilton is a rural/urban community nestled between Lake Ontario and Rice Lake in Northumberland County, one hour east of Toronto next door to Cobourg. The Township is currently seeking a Livestock Valuer.

The Ontario Wildlife Damage Compensation Program provides compensation to eligible owners whose livestock or poultry have been injured or killed as a result of wildlife. The Livestock Valuer is appointed by the Township to investigate incidents of loss of livestock or poultry from predatory wildlife.

As Livestock Valuer, you must be:

- Familiar with the Ontario Wildlife Damage Compensation Program
- Available to respond to claims and investigate thoroughly within 72 hours of being notified
- Experienced collecting evidence to determine the following:
 - The likelihood that evidence indicates that damages were caused by an eligible predator.
 - Presence of the injured animal or carcass.
 - Evidence that the livestock/poultry bled from the attack.
 - Signs of tissue damage (bruising) under the lacerations and puncture wounds.
 - Signs of a struggle, drag marks, broken vegetation and/or blood around the site.
 - Reasonable care measures have been taken by the livestock/poultry owner.
