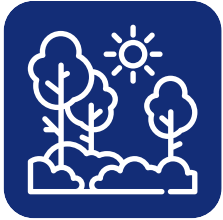




# By-law Quick Reference Guide



## Parks

- Parks close at 11:00 p.m.
- Public docks and waterfront areas are for daytime use only.
- Camping, campfires, smoking, and barbeques are not permitted.



## Parking

- No parking in a fire route or blocking a fire hydrant.
- No parking in areas that obstruct snow plowing routes between Nov 15 – April 15 annually.



## Noise

- Loudspeakers and sound amplifiers may not be used between 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. the next day (9:00 a.m. on Sundays).
- Persistent noise from domestic animals is not permitted at any times.



## Dogs

- All dogs living in the Township of Hamilton must have a valid dog tag every year.
- Dog tags are distributed by the Northumberland Humane Society.
- All dogs must be leashed in public spaces.
- You must pick up after your dog.



## Off Road Vehicles

- From Apr 1 – Nov 30, ORVs may operate on permitted roads between dusk and dawn only.
- Permitted on all Township of Hamilton roads and on specific sections of County roads found in by-law.
- Enforcement by OPP.



## Open Air Burning

- From Apr 1 – Oct 31 there is no daytime burning between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- You will need to obtain a burn permit to have an open air fire.
- No burning at all during fire bans.



## Garbage/Littering

- Please keep waste with you or place in the appropriate receptacle in public spaces.
- Residential garbage and recycling pickup and disposal is handled by Northumberland County.
