Property tax bills are mailed at the end of January and mid-May.

Administrative Monetary Penalty System (AMPS)

The Township of Hamilton has introduced an Administrative Monetary Penalty System (AMPS) to make resolving certain by-law violations faster, simpler, and more convenient.

AMPS applies to select by-laws, including parking and pool enclosure regulations, and provides an alternative to going through the court system under the Provincial Offences Act. This streamlined process is designed to be fair, easy to navigate, and quicker for residents.

Roads Update Spring clean-up is underway! Street sweeping is now complete across the Township, within hamlets and villages. Our crews are continuing with seasonal work, including roadside brushing, routine pothole maintenance, gravel road grading, and repairing or replacing road signs. Preparations are also in progress for upcoming summer road projects throughout the Township. Please drive cautiously around work zones and watch for crews and equipment.

Parks and Facilities Updates

With spring now underway, staff have been busy preparing our parks and facilities for the summer season. Playground inspections have been completed, and all playgrounds are ready for children and families to enjoy. The docks at the Bewdley Waterfront have also been installed in time for boating season, and park washrooms are now open for summer use.

Renovations to the ball diamonds at Baltimore Recreation Centre Park have now been completed, including the installation of new red clay infields on all four diamonds. We are expecting a busy summer season at the park with both youth and adult ball activities taking place.

In addition, the walkway lighting project for the Baltimore Park pathway has been awarded, with installation expected to begin in mid-June!

Be Prepared Know Your Risks



*Never leave your cooking, or candles unattended

*Discard ashes from woodstoves or fireplaces properly

*Smoke outside

*Give space heaters space around flammable & combustible materials



*Make sure your home has battery-operated/backup smoke and carbon monoxide (CO) alarms

*Portable generators are only to be used outside and ensure exhaust fumes do not enter your home

*After a snow or ice storm ensure all exhaust vents are clear



*Be prepared for anything and plan for 72 hours

*Have an emergency kit readily available and ensure everyone knows where to find it

*Don't forget to plan for pets when building your kit

Daytime Burning Restriction in Effect

A reminder to all residents of the Township of Hamilton that beginning April 1, 2026, daytime burning is not permitted between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. seven days a week, including holidays.

Agricultural and Commercial day time burns must be approved by the Fire Department.
